Varieties: Tempranillo and Garnacha. Ageing: More than 16 months in French and American oak barrels. Harvest Harvesting is carried out throughout the month of October. The grapes are placed in 15 kg boxes and undergo a selection process at the

Vineyard: Old vines with low yields, located in la Sonsierra (Rioja Alta). Alcohol Content: 13,5% Vol

Tasting notes

Visual: Attractive cherry red colour of medium to deep robe.



Nose: Intense and complex aroma, in which the appetising notes of ripe fruit intermingle with those of berries, spices and tabaco.



Palate: The attack is gentle, but the wine opens out on its passage through the mouth to become powerful and fat. The fruity notes follow each other in waves, well integrated with toasted sensations. The finish is reminiscent of minerals and undergrowth. Long and pleasant aftertaste.

Origin

All wine is the result of a pact: between nature and location, between the vineyard and human effort. Poor terroirs in a privileged location, low yielding old Tempranillo vineyards, extensive selection of grapes and a respectful production are the four elements that come together in the collection El Pacto.
